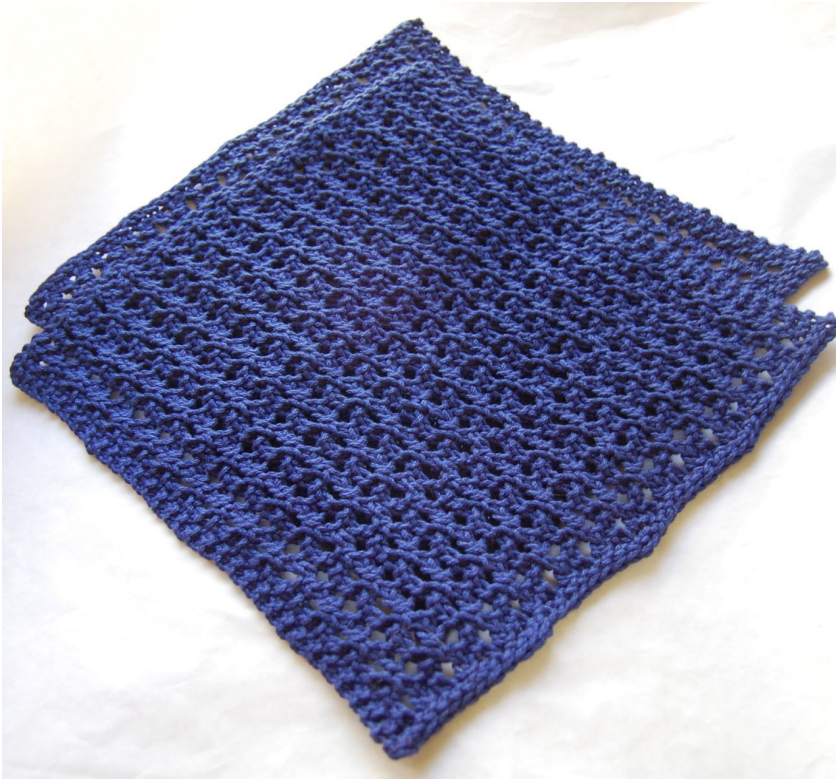


# Scrubby Dishcloth

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**DESCRIPTION:** A fast and fun knit - 100% cotton dishcloth with a reversible lace textured design.

**SIZE:** One size; 9" x 9" after blocking (blocking is not necessary).

**MATERIALS:** Elann Super Cable Aran (100% Mercerized Cotton; 85m (93yds) per 50g skein); one skein color 2612, French Navy, or 80-90 yds of any similar weight 100% cotton yarn. US size 6 (4mm) needles or size needed to obtain gauge (I used Addi Turbo 16" circulars and knit back and forth).

**GAUGE:** 5 sts/inch. Gauge is not especially crucial with this project except when calculating yarn amounts. I knit this dishcloth with smaller needles than recommended and knit fairly tightly to make a strong fabric. Even still, I had about 20 yards left over, so I could have made the cloth bigger or knit less tightly.

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Using long tail cast-on, co 43 sts (39 sts plus 4 edge sts). To make a bigger cloth, co any multiple of 3 sts plus 4 for the edges. Leave at least an 8" tail to weave in.

Knit 2 rows. Begin pattern:

Row 1 - k2, [p1, ssk, yo], end k2

Row 2 & 4 - k2, [k1, p2], end k2

Row 3 - k2, [p1, yo, k2tog], end k2

Work 15 repeats of rows 1-4. Knit 2 rows; bind off. Weave in ends. Block, if desired.
